

Statement regarding extraordinary meeting to be held on 9 December

8 December 2025

Sheringham Town Council will hold an extraordinary meeting on Tuesday, 9 December 2025, to consider matters relating to the bus shelter on Otterndorf Green. The first part of the meeting will be open for public participation, and the Council welcomes all views.

Following this, the meeting will move into a confidential session. This is not to avoid transparency, but to allow councillors to consider legal and commercial advice alongside the points raised. The exclusion of press and public is lawful and follows standard procedure for discussions exempt under the Public Bodies (Admissions to Meetings) Act 1960.

Our councillors are unpaid public servants who are committed to acting in the best interests of the town and its residents. They are volunteers who share the community's concerns and aim to find a balanced solution that supports both local needs and future development.
