Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Sheringham (NTRO9427) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency electrical repairs the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Beeston Road from its junction with Salisbury Road for 10m northwards and 30m southwards (the "Road A") and Salisbury Road from its junction with Beeston Road for 10m westwards (the "Road B") in the Town of Sheringham will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: A) Beeston Road, Cromer Road, Weybourne Road, Church Street, High Street, Wyndham Street and B) Cremer Street, Barford Road.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the roads A-B or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 11th to 18th March 2025, but the Roads A-B may continue to be closed/restricted until the 31st March 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 31st March 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: UK Power Network.

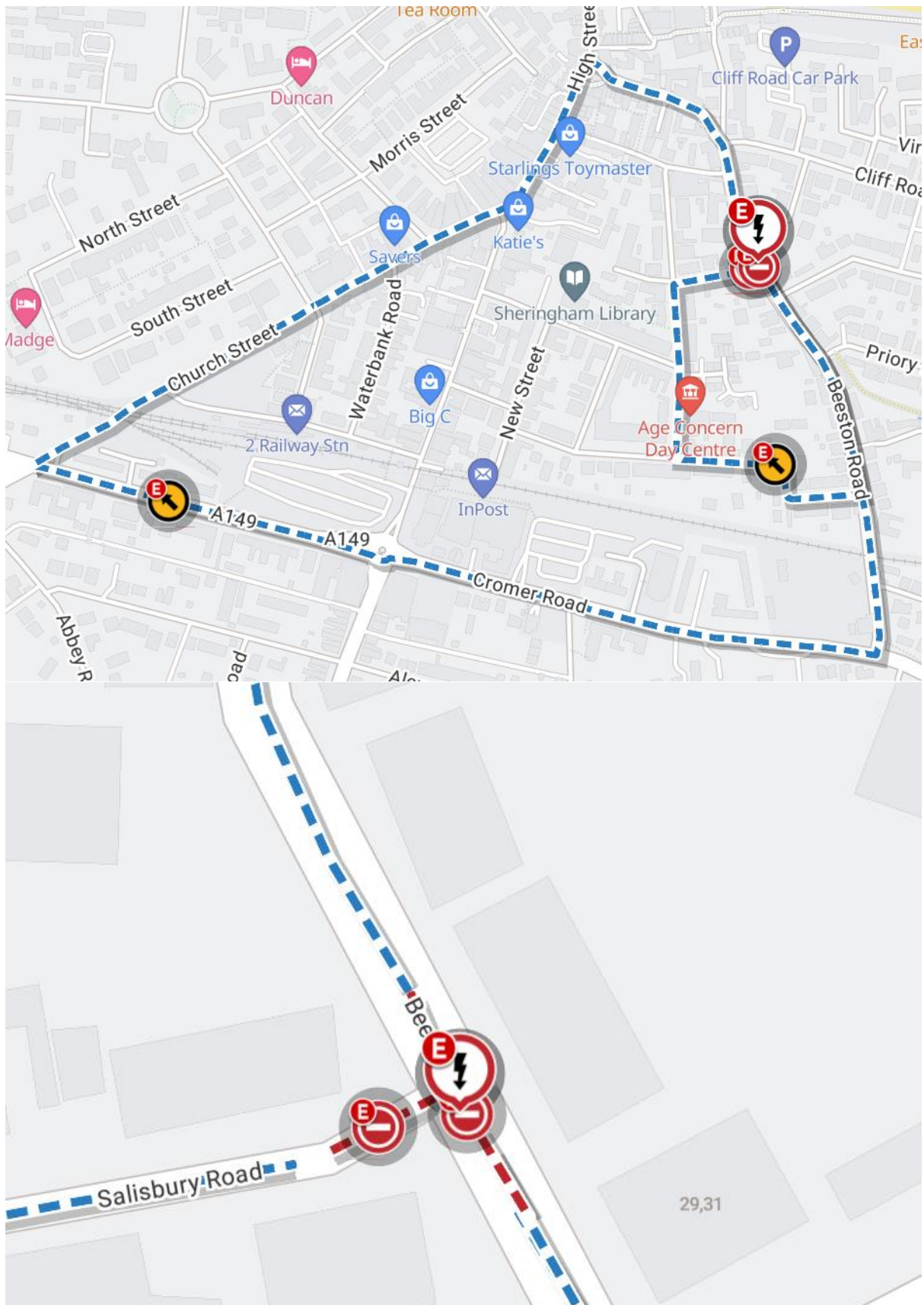
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
