

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO9194) affecting the A149 Weybourne Road from its junction with the U14356 Weybourne Road for 1.41km westwards (the "Road") in the Parish of Upper Sheringham to facilitate BT telegraph pole test works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 08:59 to 15:30 on 20th March 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 1st May 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: A149 Sheringham Road, The Street, Kelling Road, Salthouse Road, Coast Road, High Street, Coast Road, Cley Road, New Road, B1156 Langham Road, Holt Road, Smokers Hole, Brinton Road, A148 Holt Road, Fakenham Road, Letheringsett Hill, HOLT Bypass, Cromer Road, Holt Road, A1082 Holway Road, A149 Cromer Road, A149 Weybourne Road (Sheringham, Weybourne, Kelling, Salthouse, Cley-Next-The-Sea, Blakeney, Langham, Field Dalling, Brinton, Thornage, Letheringsett with Galndford, Holt, High Kelling, Bodham)

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 1st May 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

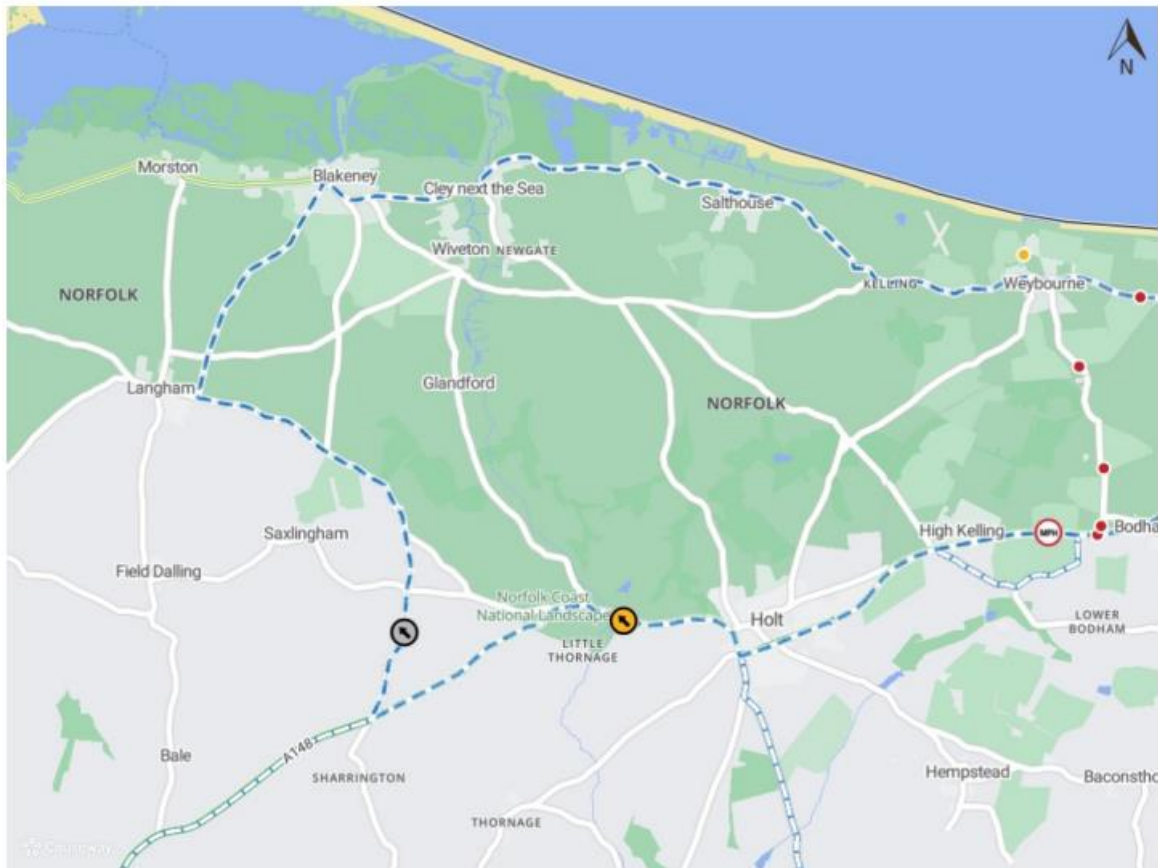
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

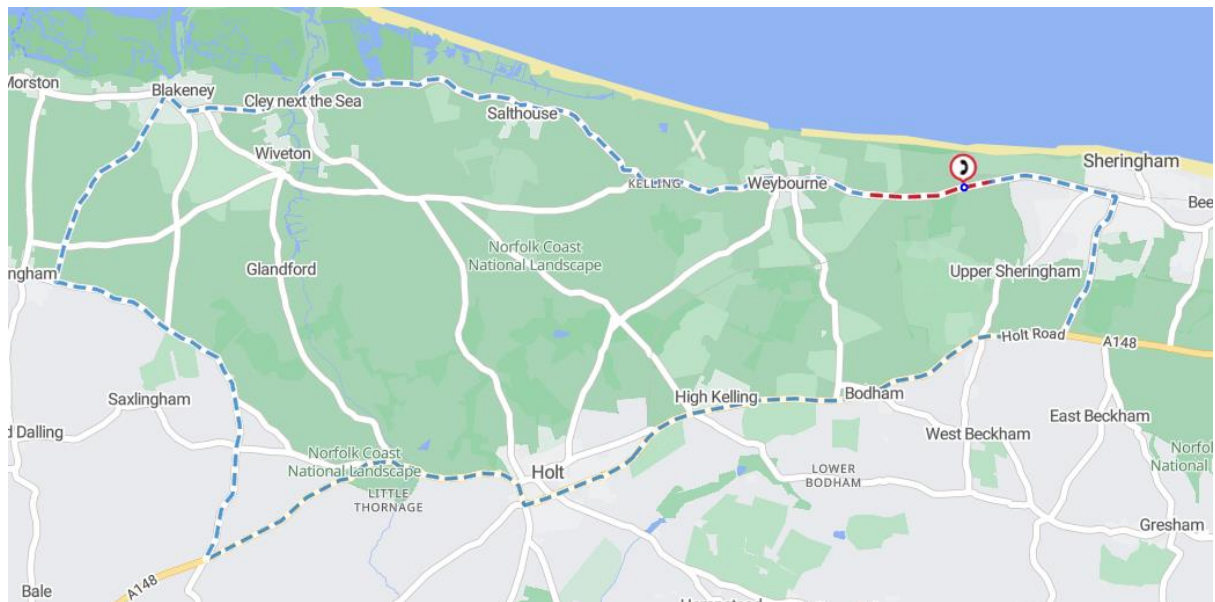
